

# UltraVan #247

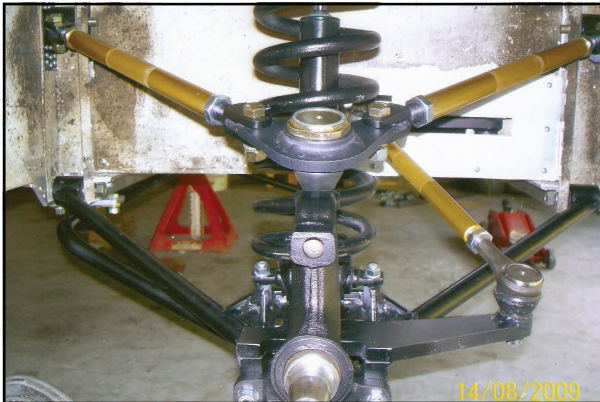

After getting 247 into the garage in the fall of '07 we started to take it apart. This turned out to be the worst and smelliest job one could imagine. After 11 years in the woods, it was hard to believe where mice can get into. We have it stripped down to a bare aluminum box on wheels. All we could do at this point was to step back and say "good Lord what have we gotten into"!

Since then Glenn has made forms to fabricate new ribs for the damaged side panel and for the new entry door. Joann is finally getting the hand of "bucking" rivets. Glenn has molded in new LED tail lights and mounted new LED turn, back-up and running lights, designed and had fabricated new upper and lower front A-frames, spring supports and sway bar and redesigned and had fabricated new steering components and brake assemblies to accommodate hand controls.

New gray and black tanks have been fabricated and installed and a new fuel tank was redesigned, built and installed. New rear trailing arms have been designed and installed. A new floor has been installed so we can start working on the interior while waiting for the engine rebuild.

Future plans call for a new dash to include gauges, rear mounted TV camera, GPS and radio/CD player. A flip down TV will be added to the overhead console.
